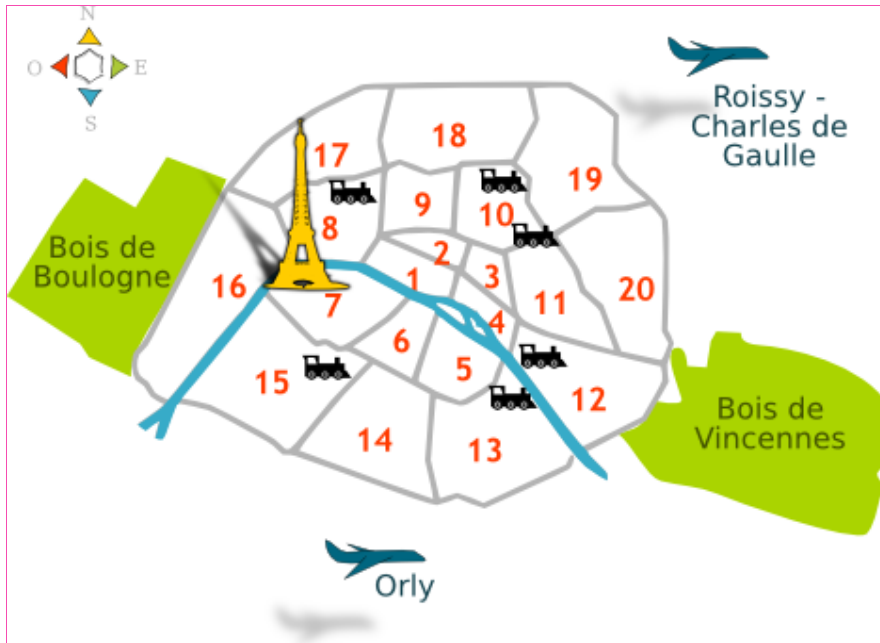


## Useful information

### About Paris and the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris (CIUP)



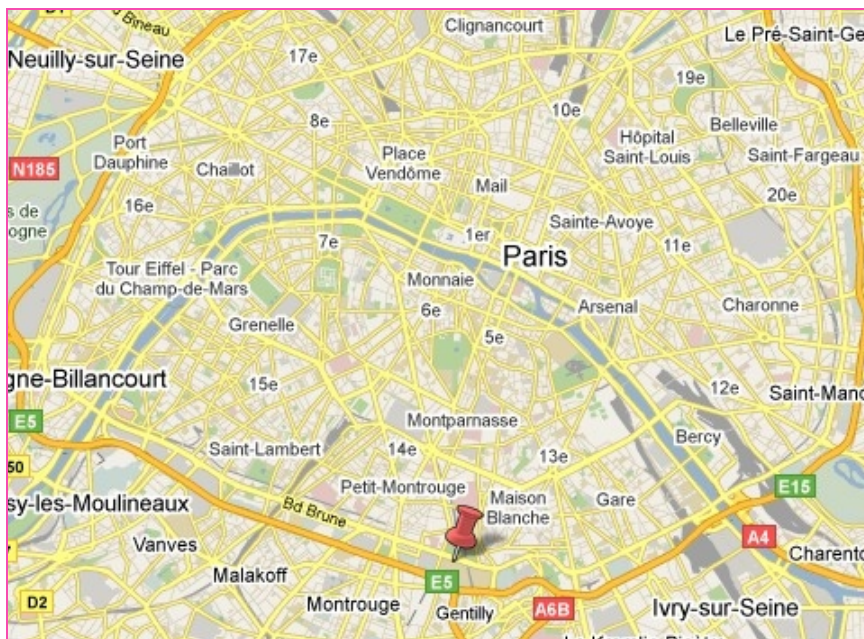
- Paris is divided into 20 "arrondissements" which are local administrative areas. These areas are numbered as a spiral out from the centre of the city.
- zip codes used for Paris: 750XX, where XX is the arrondissement.

### To come to the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris (CIUP)

The CIUP is connected to the entire highway system via the ring-road. Whatever the arrival point, train station or airport, the various transport methods provide optimal access to visitors.

- **From Roissy CDG Airport**

Go to "Aéroport Ch. de Gaulle 1" Station or to "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 2 TGV". Take **RER B** (city train), direction "Saint-Rémy-les-Chevreuse", stop at "Cité Universitaire" station (travel time 45').

- **From Orly Airport**

Go to "Orly-Ouest" **Métro** station, and take **Orly-val**, direction "Antony", and stop at "Antony" station. Then take **RER B** to "Cité Universitaire" station (travel time 37').

- **From Gare de l'Est Station**

Go to "Gare de l'Est" **Métro** station, and take **Métro 4**, direction "Porte d'Orléans" and stop at "Chatelet-les Halles". Then take **RER B** (city train), direction "Saint-Rémy-les-Chevreuse" and stop at "Cité Universitaire" station (travel time 32').
